Summer 2011: The legislature has approved new legislative maps. Illinois will lose one federal congressional district (from 19 to 18). Redistricting is required to account for the most recent census data (2010). A lawsuit has been filed challenging the new maps.

Illinois Rep. Ron Stephens, R-Greenville, is resigning immediately. After redistricting, he would have had to run either in a new district or against Rep. John Cavaletto, R-Salem. Stephens, a licensed pharmacist, was put on probation in 2001 after the Department of Professional Regulation found that he was habitually abusing controlled substances. In 2010, Stephens pleaded guilty to DUI but was given 12 months of court supervision. By resigning his office before the end of his term in January 2013, he allowed the Republican party officials in his district to appoint a successor to hold the seat until then.
